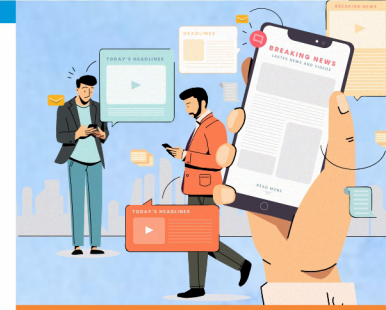

## Union Power Minister visits 2400 MW Tehri Hydro Power Complex

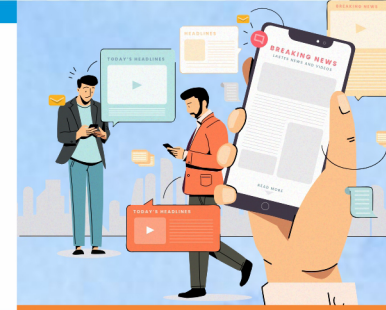
