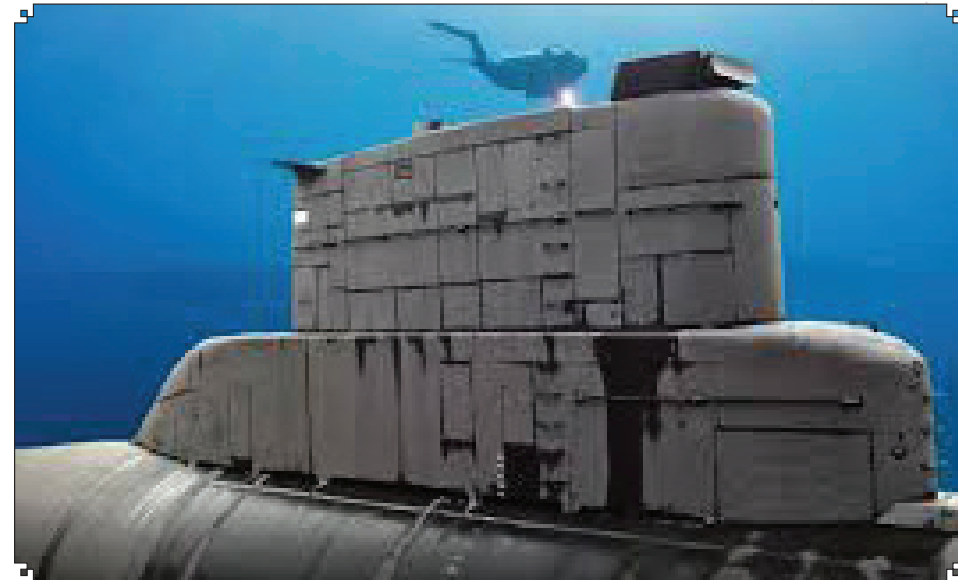
REC Plans To Be Zero NPA Company In FY25, Says CMD VK Devangan
