NTPC develops Geo-polymer aggregate from fly ash



Shri Ajay Sharma, Head of Project at NTPC Kahalgaon, inaugurated a pioneering Geopolymer Road on World Environment Day. This innovative project is the first of its kind in Bihar, constructed entirely without cement.

The Geopolymer Road, spanning 2.9 kilometers, marks a milestone for NTPC Kahalgaon. Complementing the road inauguration, NTPC Kahalgaon unveiled "The Statue of Green Innovation," also built using geopolymer concrete. NTPC mobilizes young minds for Cleanliness Drive

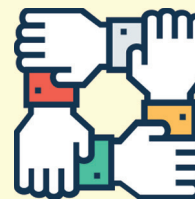

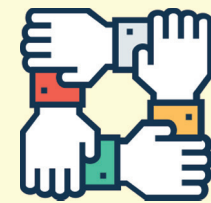
