SECL plants over 1.46 Lakh Saplings under Ek Ped Maa Ke Naam campaign

In a significant move to bolster the leadership capabilities within India's Central Public Sector Enterprises (CPSEs), the Capacity Building Commission (CBC), in collaboration with the Standing Conference of Public Enterprises (SCOPE), has unveiled the 'DAKSH' program—an initiative aimed at advancing the leadership competencies of senior executives in CPSEs.

As CPSEs continue to play a pivotal role in the country's socio-economic landscape, contributing over 13% to India's GDP, the need for agile and future-ready leaders has never been more pressing. The launch of the DAKSH program is a strategic step toward empowering the next generation of leaders in CPSEs, ensuring that they are well-equipped to lead their organizations through the challenges and opportunities of tomorrow.

Mission Karmayogi, a nationwide initiative to enhance the competence of civil servants, including those in CPSEs, underpins the importance of such leadership programs.

The program is set to commence later this year, targeting over 1,500 senior executives across CPSEs.

DMRC Achieves Major Milestone in Phase 4 Tunneling on Golden Line



The Delhi Metro Rail Corporation (DMRC) has completed a significant tunneling milestone on the Tughlakabad-Aerocity corridor of Phase 4. A Tunnel Boring Machine (TBM) broke through at Chhatarpur Mandir Station after completing an 865-meter tunnel at an average depth of 15 meters. The breakthrough event was attended by key officials, including Delhi's Lieutenant Governor Vinai Kumar Saxena and Transport Minister Kailash Gahlot. This new tunnel, part of the 19.343-kilometer underground stretch of the corridor, was constructed using the Earth Pressure Balancing Method (EPBM). Despite challenges like shifting a 66 KV electrical line and tunneling below the existing Yellow Line viaduct, the project was completed without disrupting ongoing metro operations.

DMRC Phase-4 expansion will feature Platform Screen Doors to help manage passenger queues



The PSDs for elevated stations will match those on the Pink and Magenta lines of Phase-3. In contrast, the 27 underground stations will have full-height PSDs, standing 2.15 meters tall, across approximately 40 kilometers of the underground corridor.

DMRC Principal Executive Director Anuj Dayal explained that PSDs are crucial for crowd management, as they help passengers queue efficiently. "The PSDs are installed primarily as a crowd management feature in the stations, as these gates help passengers to queue up properly near the designated door areas. These gates also ensure safer travel for the passenger," Dayal said. Officials have reported that the Phase 4 expansion project is advancing quickly, with plans to complete three priority corridors totaling 65 kilometers by 2026.

DMRC Launches Digital QR Ticketing for Commuters through Amazon Pay



The Delhi Metro Rail Corporation (DMRC) has Introduced a digital QR ticketing system for commuters in partnership with Amazon Pay. This new system aims to provide a seamless, contactless, and efficient experience for the millions of daily users of the Delhi Metro. Commuters can now purchase mobile QR tickets through Amazon Pay by selecting the 'Delhi Metro QR ticket' option, choosing their departure and destination stations, and completing the payment process. The QR ticket is then generated instantly on their mobile devices.

At metro stations, users simply need to scan the QR code on their smartphones at the Automatic Fare Collection (AFC) gates to gain entry and exit. Dr. Vikas Kumar, Managing Director of DMRC, stated, "Partnering with Amazon Pay for QR ticketing will make daily journeys more efficient and enjoyable. This innovative approach offers convenience, reduces paper waste, and supports our sustainability efforts." This new system marks a significant step towards enhancing the commuting experience and promoting eco-friendly practices in Delhi's public transportation network.


